



FRAMEWORK AGREEMENTS CAN BE ACTIVATED TO MANAGE, MITIGATE, OR RESOLVE ISSUES ALLOWING FOR RAPID, COMPLIANT, AND EFFICIENT ACTIVATION OF SERVICES WHEN PROBLEMS ARISE

Key Types of Agreements for Issues

Master Services Agreements (MSAs): These set the high-level legal and commercial terms (liability, IP, governing law) that govern all future work orders or Statements of Work (SOWs).

Emergency/Call-Off Contracts: "activated" to address immediate, unforeseen needs without needing to go through a lengthy procurement process. They are often used for IT service disruptions or urgent supplier replacements.

Service Level Agreements (SLAs): Usually embedded within a framework, these define acceptable performance levels and specify penalties (service credits) or breach-of-contract remedies if the vendor fails to meet them

Mechanisms for Activating Support

Immediate Call-Offs: If a primary vendor fails, a pre-negotiated framework allows the enterprise to instantly engage a backup supplier (in a multi-supplier framework) or trigger an emergency SOW.

Change Orders/Directives: These are formal, contractually defined procedures for altering project scope, which can be activated when a project encounters unexpected technical issues or bottlenecks.


Force Majeure Clauses: These are standard in enterprise contracts, allowing for suspension of obligations in the event of uncontrollable, unforeseen circumstances.

Microsoft 365 hit by outage, preventing access to emails and files

An ongoing Microsoft outage is preventing enterprise customers from accessing email inboxes, files, meetings, and other Microsoft cloud services.

The technology giant said in a [post on X](#) around 2:30 p.m. ET that the outage was caused by a “portion of service infrastructure in North America that is not processing traffic as expected.” Microsoft didn’t provide specific details of the cause of the outage, but said it was “working to restore the infrastructure to a healthy state to achieve recovery.”








